Jr Youth Leader^**

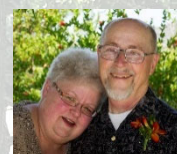
Brooke and husband Corey and 2 children live in Benton. They are very active in their home church, The Well at Benton United Methodist Church.
